- 09-04A **Home Invasion/Burglary:** Up to \$1,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of Clinton Roach. Roach was identified as the 3rd person that committed the home invasion/Burglary occurring 03/17/2009 at Flicker Way in Anderson. He has a warrant for his arrest not related to this investigation. **SCSO** 03/28/09
- 09-03A **Armed Robbery:** Up to \$2,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect that robbed the Palo Cedro Pharmacy with a handgun. Crime occurred 2/5/09 at approximately 6pm. The suspect was described as a white male, 5'11" to 6' tall, with a slender build, wearing a green fatigue hooded jacket and blue pants. **SCSO** 02/08/09
- 09-02A **Arson:** Up to \$2,500 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) that set the playground structure on fire at the Bella Vista School. The structure was destroyed. Damage estimated at \$50,000. The crime occurred June 11, 2008 at approximately 7 pm.

- 09-01A **Burglary:** Up to \$2,000.00 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) that stole a Platinum /Gold ladies ring with large diamond setting from Olde West Gun & Loan Co., 568 Market St., Redding on 11/03/08. Time unknown. **RPD** 01/08/08
- 08-32A **Armed Robbery:** Up to \$2,500.00 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect that robbed the Time To Stop Mini Mart at 5425 Mountain View Dr., Redding. Suspect entered the business brandishing a handgun, demanded money from the clerk at gunpoint. The clerk complied and the suspect fled out the front doors. Suspect was wearing a dark colored hooded sweatshirt and blue jeans. Suspect's face was partially covered with a bandana or similar type cloth. Suspect was possibly seen leaving the scene in a tan colored van. Crime occurred 12/28/2008 at 4:03pm. **RPD** 12/31/08
- 08-31A **Commercial burglary:** Up to \$1,000.00 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) that burglarized and vandalized a series of Redding commercial businesses between the dates of 11/15/2008 and 12/16/2008 during the late evening/early morning hours.

- 08-29A **Grand Theft:** Up to \$250.00 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) that took newspaper boxes during the month of November. Suspect male, late 20s early 30s, approximately 5'10", 160 pounds brandished a handgun demanding cash from the clerk. - Stevens' body was discovered in a burned house located at 13445 Old Oregon Trail, Redding by the fire personnel. The house fire appeared to have been set in an effort to cover up the homicide. **SCSO**
- 07-14A Up to \$2,500. For information leading to the arrest of the person who robbed the US Bank. 1110 Dana Dr., Redding on Aug 24, 2007 at 3:08pm. The suspect is an adult, black male, 4'11" to 5'2" tall, 135 to 150 lbs, short black hair, and large bulging brown eyes. He was last seen wearing a white and blue-sleeved t-shirt and blue jeans. The suspect entered the bank and presented the teller with a demand note that indicated he was armed but no weapon was seen. The suspect fled the bank with an undisclosed amount of money. **RPD**
- 07-13A Up to \$10,000. For information in regards to the homicide of Walter James that was found in a trailer. The incident occurred on Aug 15, 2007 at approx. 4:00am at 11546 Bluff Rd., Bella vista. **SCSO**
