**INDIVIDUAL FIRE CONTROL OBJECTIVES:**

<b>Fire Name: Chalk</b>	<b>Acres: 6,923</b>
Interior islands continue to burn out. Potential for spot fires still exist. Full containment expected in 12 hours. Mandatory evacuations lifted for Skunk Ridge Rd. Threat to PG&E facilities mitigated. Mopup and fireline suppression repair continue.	

<b>Fire Name: Burney LCA &amp; Cassel</b>	<b>Acres: 6,751</b>
Fireline suppression repair efforts continue. Mop-up operations continue on lines that have held.

<b>Fire Name: Goose</b>	<b>Acres: 3,949</b>
Mop-up is continuing with fireline suppression and repair as well as cultural resource assessment is ongoing.
